

## CUP RULES

the following rules will apply in unison with any other information given by the league on the format of the competition.

All matches will be played under the laws of the game.

1. Any bona-fide player in the relative age group who is duly registered by this league can take part in these competitions provided that he has played one match during the current season unless through no fault of his own the player has failed to qualify then the player who has registered with his team since the start of the season shall be eligible to play in any cup game including semi-final and final.
2. No player can play for more than one team in either of the cup competitions.  
No player can play for more than one team age group even in his own club.
3. Eligibility for semi-finals – a player must have played not less than 3 games for the team with whom registered.
4. Eligibility for finals – a player must have played not less than 3 games and 1 cup game for the team with whom registered.
5. Any team proved guilty of league rules **8(M)(i), refusing to play against the team they have been drawn against or falsifying a match sheet** whilst playing in a cup competition will be expelled from the round that the offence occurred (opposing team will be awarded a walkover) and all future cup games that season. If playing on a group basis all results will be expunged. And will be liable for any expenses incurred by match officials.
6. The league stand down rule does not apply to cup competitions. Any team failing to fulfil a fixture will be removed from the competition. Should this be semis or finals then losing teams from previous round will be progressed through.
7. In all games prior to the finals, each team shall appoint an assistant referee. The management committee shall if possible appoint assistant referees for all finals.
8. The management committee shall take the receipts of all finals and after meeting expenses the balance shall be handed over to the league funds.
9. Any matters arising and not dealt with in the foregoing rules shall be decided by the management committee whose decision shall be final subject to the right of appeal to B.C.F.A.
